Mon 20 Jul : Meet at 12:30 with the tour leader at the Malta International Airport. Check in for our flight TK1372 departing at 19:25 to Istanbul and arriving 22:55 (Local time)

Tue 21 Jul : (B/D/-)

At 01:40, we depart on flight TK56, arriving at **Jakarta** International Airport at 17:35 (local time).

Welcome to Indonesia!

We'll transfer to the city center and check in at our **4-star Holiday Inn Gaja Mada**, where assistance will be provided during the check-in process. Enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel. Jakarta, the capital and largest city of Indonesia, is located on the northwest coast of Java Island. It serves as the country's economic, and political hub, and is the most populous city not only in Indonesia but in all of Southeast Asia. The city boasts a vibrant nightlife, exciting shopping districts, and a unique blend of Indonesian cultures, making it a fascinating destination to explore and experience.

Wed 22 Jul : **Jakarta City Tours** (B/L/-)

After breakfast we start our journey in the breathtaking **National Monument** (Monas). Head to the heart of Merdeka Square where this towering National Monument (Monas) stands 132 meters (433 feet) tall. Explore the iconic symbol of Indonesia's independence. Take a leisurely stroll around the surrounding area. Continue to the magnificent Istiqlal Mosque, the biggest mosque in Southeast Asia, is the next stop on our tour. A feeling of serenity and spirituality is evoked by its magnificent architecture and calm ambience. Jakarta's rich history and diverse population are reflected in the cathedral's majesty and elaborate architecture. Continue to the **Taman Mini Miniature Park**, a sprawling cultural park. See the diversity of Indonesia on display in a single location. Explore the meticulously crafted traditional houses from various provinces, each showcasing distinct architectural styles.

Lunch at local restaurant. You are driven back to hotel and leisure.

Thu 23 Jul : **Jakarta - Yogyakarta - Prambanan Temple** (B/L/-)

After breakfast, transfer to airport to board the flight to Yogyakarta (1hr). Arrive to Yogyakarta, and transfer to local restaurant for lunch. After lunch, visit Prambanan Temple, the Most Beautiful and Graceful Hindu Temple in Indonesia. Prambanan is a magnificent spectacle and an icon of Indonesia's cultural heritage.. The biggest temple is dedicated to Shiva – the destroyer, and the two smaller ones which sit on its right and left are dedicated to Brahma, the creator, and Wisnu, the sustainer. The tallest temple of Prambanan is a staggering 47 meters high. Its peak visible from far away and rises high above the ruins of the other temples. Then we proceed to our **4 Stars Hotel Royal Malioboro by Aston** located in the city centre -check in. The rest of the day at leisure to enjoy shopping at Jalan Malioboro, the never stop street in Yogyakarta



Fri 24 Jul : Yogyakarta – Borobudur – Bali

(B/L/D)

After breakfast and check-out, pay a visit to Borobudur Temple, a Majestic Wonder of Indonesia. Borobudur Temple is the world's largest Buddhist monument and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, located in Magelang, Central Java, about 1.5 hours from Yogyakarta. Built in the 9th century during the Sailendra Dynasty, this architectural masterpiece remains one of the most significant Buddhist sites in the world. You will walk through its nine stacked platforms with intricate stone carvings that tell Buddhist stories. Enjoy panoramic views of the lush landscape from the top of the temple. If time permits, you will pay a visit to nearby smaller temples Pawon and Mendut offer beautiful stone reliefs and a peaceful atmosphere. Return to Yogyakarta and there is a break for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, depart to the airport to board your flight to Denpasar, Bali. Upon arrival to Bali, transfer to our **4 Stars Hotel Bali Bintang Resort** in the area of Kuta Beach. Dinner at hotel. Bali, the famed Island of the Gods, with its varied landscape of hills and mountains, rugged coastlines and sandy beaches, lush rice terraces, and barren volcanic hillsides all providing a picturesque backdrop to its colorful, deeply spiritual, and unique culture stakes a serious claim to be paradise on earth. With world-class surfing and diving, a large number of cultural, historical, and archaeological attractions, and an enormous range of accommodations, this is one of the world's most popular island destinations and one which consistently wins travel awards.

Sat 25 Jul : Leisure in Kuta

(B/-/-)

Today is free for you to relax and enjoy the resort's facilities, or to explore the charming town of Kuta at your own pace. You may also choose to join the tour leader for optional activities.

Sun 26 Jul : Kuta – Ubud

(B/-/-)

After breakfast, depart for **Tanah Lot Temple**, one of Bali's most iconic landmarks. Perched dramatically on a rocky outcrop along the island's southwestern coast, this temple offers breathtaking views of the Indian Ocean. Renowned for its spiritual importance and picturesque setting, Tanah Lot is a must-visit for every traveler to Bali. It is also part of the island's chain of seven sea temples, believed to guard Bali from the forces of the sea. Next, continue to **Ubud** to explore the **Sacred Monkey Forest Sanctuary** in Padangtegal, one of Ubud's most beloved attractions. This lush nature reserve is home to a lively community of grey long-tailed macaques. You can see the playful monkeys swing through the trees, relax along forest paths, or snack on bananas while strolling beneath the shade of towering nutmeg trees. Afterward, visit **Ubud Palace (Puri Saren Agung)** and the **Ubud Market**, located just across the main street. The palace remains a symbol of Balinese art and culture, while the nearby market offers a colorful array of handicrafts and local goods. Later, check in at **4 Stars BW Premier Resort**, ideally situated for easy access to Ubud's shopping and dining areas—perfect for picking up unique Bali souvenirs to take home.

Mon 27 Jul: North Bali Encounter

(B/L/-)

After breakfast, embark on a full-day journey to discover the natural beauty and cultural treasures of **North and East Bali**. Begin with a visit to **Tirta Empul Temple**, a sacred Hindu water temple famed for its holy spring. Continue to **Tirta Gangga**, the former royal water palace surrounded by beautifully landscaped gardens, elegant fountains, and tranquil ponds filled with lotus flowers and vibrant koi fish. Next, marvel at the **Tegallalang Rice Terraces**, one of Bali's most iconic landscapes. This breathtaking valley showcases the island's traditional *subak* irrigation system and offers endless photo opportunities amidst lush greenery. End the day at **Tukad Cepung Waterfall**, a hidden gem tucked within a canyon. As sunlight streams through the rocks, it creates a magical display of light and mist — a truly enchanting sight. Lunch included.

Tue 28 Jul : Leisure in Ubud

(B/-/-)

Today, enjoy a day at leisure. Relax and make the most of the resort's facilities, or set out to explore the enchanting towns and surroundings of Bali at your own pace. Alternatively, join your tour leader for an optional excursion to discover even more of the island's charm.

Wed 29 Jul : Highlight of Ubud

(B/L/-)

After breakfast depart to visit the mystical **Kehen Temple** in Bangli Regency. This old temple has an exceptional carving on its shrines, covered by a massive sacred Banyan tree at the second court that magnificently rises the atmosphere of ancient Balinese times. Here you could witness the high level of Balinese art of carving applied on its architecture. Continue to **Penglipuran Village** that is known for its unique houses, social life system, and culture. This distinctive village is situated on the countryside, below the bamboo forest, and designed symmetrically from north to south. Here you could see the Balinese house compounds and its traditional shape decorated by the local materials. Afterwards, continue to **Kintamani** as it has many hanging restaurant that provides splendid view of Mount and Caldera Lake Batur. At the afternoon proceed to **The Mother Temple of Besakih** that is located on the slope of the **Mount Agung**, where the dozens of particular temples are surrounding the main Penataran Agung Temple. This place is the ceiling of the island, regarded as the destination for every Balinese Hindus to worship in their ancestral temple. This is the perfect place to witness the authentic Balinese Hindu practices. Breathtaking and peaceful vibes rendering the rhythmic bliss. Lunch included.

Thu 30 Jul : Ubud – Padang Bai – Gili Trawangan

(B/L/D)

Breakfast, transfer to Padangbai port and board high speed ferry to Gili Trawangan (2 hrs.) upon arrival, you are transfer by horse carriage to our **4 Stars Hotel Villa Ombak** nestled within tropical gardens on the island paradise of Gili Trawangan. Swim alongside **green and hawksbill sea turtles**. Explore the enchanting **underwater sculpture “Nest”**, created by artist *Jason deCaires Taylor*, near Gili Meno. Snorkel over **vibrant artificial reefs (biorocks)** teeming with marine life. Glide above the **Bounty Wreck**, a sunken pontoon lying about 8 meters below the surface. Lunch included .

After your adventure, return to the hotel and **relax at your leisure** for the rest of the afternoon.

Sat 01 Aug : Gili Trawangan - Sanur

(B/-/-)

After breakfast and check-out, say goodbye to Gili Trawangan and board the boat back to Bali. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to our **4 Stars Hotel Sanur resort Water Jinbar** in the serene **Padang Padang** area, famous for its pristine beach, turquoise waters, and relaxed atmosphere for an overnight stay, where you can relax and enjoy on the beach .

Sun 02 Aug : Cooking Class and Balinese Massage

After breakfast, enjoying the Balinese way of cooking can be a wonderful thing to experience during your visit to the “Island of the Gods”. At cooking Class, we would love the opportunity to teach you how to make Balinese food. Balinese food has a specific character and spices have an important role in creating the unique flavor. You will be taught the traditional methods for preparing Balinese food, including how we utilize the special tropical plants, roots, and herbs found on the “Island of the Gods”. All the menu will be made by yourself, then you will savor the delight that you have for lunch. You will also explore the local or traditional market, meet the farmers and learn how they grow rice, and finally, you will learn how to make many delicious menus from authentic Balinese recipes and ingredients. Enjoy the lunch on your own cook. After lunch, you are transfer to one of the great spa sanctuary and you will have 90 Balinese Massage experience. This is a deep-tissue, holistic treatment that combines gentle stretching, acupressure, skin rolling, and firm stroking with aromatherapy oils to release muscle tension, improve circulation, and promote relaxation. The technique originated in Indonesia and is influenced by traditional Indian, Chinese, and Southeast Asian medicine systems. It is used to alleviate stress, fatigue, and physical tension, and is beneficial for both relaxation and athletic recovery. You are driven back to hotel after day’s activities

Mon 03 Aug : South Bali – Fare well Dinner (B/-/D)

After breakfast and check-out, depart for **Uluwatu**. Begin your day with a visit to **Garuda Wisnu Kencana Cultural Park**, a cultural and recreational landmark featuring the towering Garuda Wisnu Kencana statue—one of the largest in the world. Uluwatu Temple – Perched atop a dramatic cliff overlooking the Indian Ocean, this iconic sea temple offers breathtaking views and is a significant site in Balinese Hinduism.

Kecak Dance Performance – Experience the enchanting traditional Balinese Kecak dance at sunset in Uluwatu Temple’s amphitheater. The performance narrates the epic story of the Ramayana through mesmerizing chants and intricate movements.

In the evening we enjoy a **signature farewell dinner** on **Jimbaran Beach** - perfect ending to your Bali journey.

Tue 04 Aug : Sanur day at leisure and departure (B/D/-)

A day at leisure for personal sightseeing, beach time, or last-minute shopping. Rooms are available until 16:30. Transfer to Bali airport for our flight TK67 departs at 20:55
