Tue 10 Mar We meet at Malta International Airport at 05:00 to check in for our Lufthansa flight LH1315 departs 07:55 to Buenos Aires via Frankfurt.

Wed 11 Mar Buenos Aires City Tour & Tango Dinner Show

Arrive in Buenos Aires at 07:55 on LH510. After airport formalities, set out on a Buenos Aires City Tour, discovering why the city is known as the “Paris of South America.” See the Obelisk, Colón Theater, and historic squares, then explore the character-filled neighborhoods of La Boca, San Telmo, Recoleta, and Palermo. Stroll along the modern waterfront of Puerto Madero and admire the striking Woman’s Bridge. Check in at the **4 stars+ Hotel 725 Continental**, with the afternoon at leisure. In the evening, enjoy a **Tango dinner show**, featuring a three-course meal and the passion of Argentina’s most iconic dance. Overnight in Buenos Aires.

Thu 12 Mar Buenos Aires - Estancia Santa Susana

Depart Buenos Aires for a scenic drive across the Argentine pampas to Estancia Santa Susana in Los Cardales. Upon arrival, enjoy a warm welcome reception at the ranch pub with empanadas and wine. The day is filled with gaucho activities, including sulky rides or trekking across the picturesque grounds. Lunch (Included) features a traditional “asado” Parrillada (Argentinian BBQ) While dining, delight in a folk show of music and dance and watch the thrilling Boleadoras demonstration, showcasing the gauchos’ skill with their throwing weapons. After lunch, experience the excitement of gaucho horse shows, including ring races, animal herding, and the Cuadreras race. At the end of a memorable day, return to Buenos Aires .

Fri 13 Mar Buenos Aires - El Tigre

Escape to the tranquil El Tigre, a riverside retreat where Buenos Aires’ elite maintain summer homes along the Paraná River Delta. Transfer to the port, then board a small boat for a scenic cruise through the delta’s waterways. Soak in the serene atmosphere and explore the charming island communities. Visit local homes and experiencing their way of life firsthand. Return to your hotel in the afternoon and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Sat 14 Mar Cruise. Buenos Aires - Boarding the Celebrity Equinox

Tue 24 Mar Campos do Jordão - Pedra do Bau - Sao Paolo

After enjoying a hearty breakfast, we begin our journey toward São Paulo. Along the way, we will make a memorable stop at Pedra do Baú, one of the most iconic landmarks of the Mantiqueira Mountains. This striking granite formation rises dramatically from the landscape, offering sweeping viewpoints that reveal the region's valleys, forests, and surrounding peaks in all their glory. It is an ideal stop for those who wish to pause, breathe in the fresh mountain air, and be captivated by the beauty of unspoiled nature. Whether you choose to take photographs, enjoy a short walk, or simply admire the breathtaking scenery, Pedra do Baú provides an unforgettable moment of connection with the natural world before continuing on to São Paulo. Check in at the 4 stars hotel located the the city centre – **Hotel Estanplaza Paulista**

Wed 25 Mar Sao Paulo - City Tour
