Sunday 05 April Nile Cruise - Valley of the Kings

Tuesday 07 April Nile Cruise - Abu Simbel & Nile by Felucca

After breakfast we have the opportunity to visit the Great Temple of Abu Simbel, one of the most magnificent monuments. Lunch on board and then we sail on the Nile by Felucca around the Aswan Islands. Dinner on board follows by a **Nubian Show**. Overnight on board in Aswan.

Wednesday 08 April Philae Temple, Unfinished Obelisk & the High Dam

Breakfast on board and disembarkation. First we visit the Philae Temple, Unfinished Obelisk & the High Dam. Lunch at a local restaurant and then transfer to Aswan Airport to fly to Cairo. Overnight in Cairo.
